



ROBELINE HERITAGE FESTIVAL 2009 BEAUTY PAGEANT



Rules and Regulations

- 1. A contestant participating in the 2009 Robeline Heritage Festival Pageant must be single, must never have been married, nor given birth to a child.**
- 2. A contestant may not have been convicted of a felony.**
- 3. Contestant's two-page entry form, photograph no less than 5 x 7 in size (if entering photogenic), and entry fees must be received at P. O. Box 278, Robeline, LA. 71469, postmarked no later than July 21, 2009. No money or applications will be accepted after deadline or at door on event day. Photos will be returned upon request if name and address are written on back of photo.**
- 4. Contestant's in the Teen and Miss Division will be judged in 3 phases: interview, onstage introductions, and evening gown competition. The onstage introduction needs to include contestant's name, number, and invitation to Festival.**
- 5. If selected as Miss Robeline Heritage Queen, contestant agrees to represent Robeline Heritage at functions, parades, fairs and festivals, etc. in the community and surrounding areas. In the Teen and Miss Division, should the winner conduct themselves in such a manner unbecoming to their title, or should she marry, they agree to forfeit the title, crown and banner to the first alternate.**
- 6. A contestant may compete more than once for the title of Miss Robeline Heritage Queen but upon winning (age category 17-23) she may not compete again.**
- 7. The 2009 Miss Robeline Heritage Queen must attend the 2010 L.A.F. F. Convention and Pageant. Convention Entry fees and hotel room will be provided by the Festival. She must also attend the 2010 Robeline Heritage Pageant to give up her title and crown her successor.**
- 8. The Robeline Heritage Society, Inc, it's members, volunteers, or committees, will not be held responsible for any items lost or stolen, or any injuries sustained while competing in the Pageant. The same applies if chosen Queen of any category and you are representing them.**
